

## Information for Potential Food Trucks at The Langford Station

LAYOUT: Food Truck parking is on the gravel section marked orange. There is space for 5-6 trucks, depending on size.



**POWER:** The power is 30amp, 120volt and intended to support all the auxiliary power needs. Trucks that run their main cooking appliances (grills, ovens, deep fryers, etc) on electric will require a whisper generator to operate.

**WATER:** There is a hose connection on the outside of the washroom facility by the parking lot where trucks can fill their water tanks. Trucks may arrange with the City for access.

**WASTEWATER:** Trucks who park on site full time have the option of setting up a wastewater bin behind their truck. Trucks interested in this option can request more information from the City regarding pricing secured by current trucks for the tank and pump-outs.

**BOOKING OPTIONS:** The space is booked by a combination of monthly and daily rentals. For monthly rentals, trucks remaining on site are required to be open a minimum 4 days a week, every Thursday-Sunday. Daily rentals may book as many or as few days as they like and can park on site overnight if booked multiple days in a row.

COSTS: Costs vary and are set by City Bylaw 2187. Rates as of January 2025 are as follows:

- Monthly rate, June-Sept: \$666.25/month
- Monthly rate, Oct-May: \$307.5/month
- Daily Rate, June-Sept, Mon-Thurs: \$35.88/day
- Daily Rate, June-Sept, Fri-Sun: \$51.25/day
- Daily Rate, Oct-May, Mon-Thurs: \$20.50/day
- Daily Rate, Oct-May, Fri-Sun: \$25.63/day

These fees will be increased each year on May 1<sup>st</sup> by the annual percentage change in the All-Items Consumer Price Index (CPI) for Greater Victoria for the then most recently ended calendar year as published by Statistics Canada.

**APPLICATION PROCESS:** To become a Station Food Truck Vendor, applicants must follow the following steps:

- 1. Submit an application form (found on our website) with pictures of the truck and menu.
- 2. Sign a Food Truck Vendor Agreement, detailing the requirements and code of conduct for operating on site.
- 3. Apply for a City of Langford business licence, regardless of existing licences from other jurisdictions. This involves submitting an application, paying a one-time \$100 fee, and providing access for an inspection by the Langford Fire Department.
- 4. Provide copies of the main operator's Food Safe Certificate, the truck's Island Health Licence, and insurance documents. Note: Insurance requirements are laid out in the Food Truck Vendor Agreement and include:
  - commercial general liability no less than \$5,000,000 per occurrence.
  - name the City of Langford, the Island Corridor Foundation, and Victoria Contracting and Municipal Maintenance Corporation as additional insureds.
